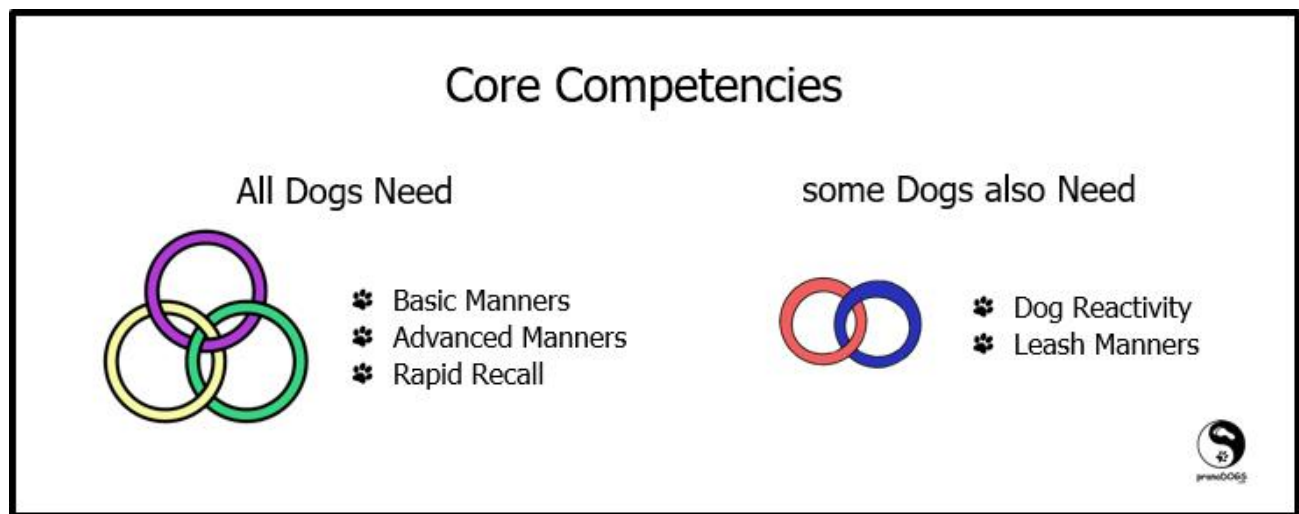




pranaDOGS offers classes in the Core Competencies – or the basic cue's and behaviors you and your dog need to have on-demand

This course also includes distraction exercises, coping mechanisms and an interactive environment filled with practice, challenges and fun activities for both dogs and their people. New dogs can come dog and participate in a class anytime. Classes run for six weeks \$120
